

## Phoenician Glass Head of a Ram

7th-5th century B.C.

**Description**

The yellow face with small rounded ears has large eyes with blue-black pupils whilst similarly coloured horns curve around the face. A small hole beneath. Beads of this type, thought to have been manufactured in Carthage, have been found in context dateable to the mid 7th - 5th century B.C. Larger examples of about 4cm high are of a later date.
