Ornament: Carved leaf and flower on cross-hatched ground; incised frieze; pierced rocaille corner and centre cartouches containing palmettes and cartouches against punched ground with floral sprays on punched ground fields, linked by outer swept bound fascies rails, inner astragal; back edge egg-and-chain molding
