**Description**

Scope and content: Series consists primarily of diaries, diary fragments and related writings by David Milne, chronicling his painting activity from Alander, N.Y. to Baptiste Lake and including the beginnings of an autobiography written in 1949. Series also includes notes for painting classes in Ottawa, written reflections on painting, and the transcript of a 1938 radio interview with Milne. A group of diaries in this series contains daily notes on painting by David Milne, dictated to Kathleen Milne.
