#### Description

Contents: Graduation diploma (1899); Milne letter to James Milne (his brother). Also contains 2 addressed envelopes and one addressed card. Note on envelope by Norman Endicott (Douglas Duncan's literary executor) explains that the letter was never mailed to James Milne. Duncan was a procrastinator and did not do many things.; W.S. Forestor (lawyer) letter; Margaret McGregor letter. A 1919 letter from one of Milne's high school teachers who was probably romantically attracted to Milne; telegram announcing death of James Milne; Public school teacher's third-class certificate; Walkerton High School commencement 1900. Milne graduated the previous year; Chas. Johnston (friend) postcard (1899); Allan Gilmour (friend) postcard (1899); Alex Eming (friend) letter(1899); A.W. Wright (The Confedarte) letter (1902); O.E. Turnbull (canadian Boy magazine) letter (1901); J.G. Whitten (botany teacher) letter (1901); Kathleen Milne, featuring list of Milne's siblings written on envelope (ca. 1950); James Milne to Milne, three letters and envelopes.
