Contents: David Milne, Jr. notes: "Part of a trench map of Vimy Ridge (or Lens - Hill 60) probably found by Milne on the battlefield in 1919. The map seems to be laying out an attack. Fragment from 'Board No. 2456' for 146H artillery battery, 18th Corp for 'Map Position of No. 1 Gun B7C3672', 18 May 1918. The villages of Drocourt, Henin Lietard and Montigny and the 'Queant - Drocourt Line' are noted on the map. Milne would have found this fragment at the gun's position, closer to Vimy-Lens."
