According to the Ghetto Fighters' House Archives, the man on the left was a streetcar conductor. Beside him is a young man who was responsible for keeping order during the deportation of Jews from the ghetto. Part of a streetcar is seen on the left, from which Jews were transported to Radogoszcz Station.
