Liceo Tasso is one of the oldest high schools in Rome. It is in the Ludovisi district and is named after Torquato Tasso, a 16th century Italian poet. During the intense years of youth protest (1968-1974), the high school often became the centre for frequent clashes between opposing political-affiliated students.
