A protester holds a hand made sign proclaiming opposition to the industrialisation of Ursini Raffaele Vittorio Ursini was an Italian entrepreneur who created Ursini industries affiliated with Liquichimica. In the seventies, the crisis of the Italian chemical sector Liquigas led to great difficulties and Ursini forced to cede all the company to Salvatore Ligresti. He was accused of false accounting, and after conviction fled to South America. 'Now it's your turn' 'workers want to kill' ''675' billions to upgrade the factories'
