Pierre Clementi was a French character actor. In 1972, he was arrested in Rome and charged with possession of LSD and cocaine. He served 17 months in an Italian prison before an appeals court acquitted and freed him. Lacking a resident visa, however, he was given 24 hours to leave Italy.
