Description

Umberto Terracini, in a black cloak, is greeted by the lawyer Guiliano Spazzali, who defended many of the activists during the anni di piombo, and an officer on Achille Lollo's trial Umberto Elia Terracini was an Italian politician and anti-Fascist, and president of the Constituent Assembly and at one point leader of the Italian Communist Party. Giuliano Spazzali was a lawyer for many of the Red Brigade's activists. After the massacre of Piazza Fontana (12 December 1969), he was responsible for the legal defence of many of the anarchists involved.
