Description

Claudio Vitalone (7 July 1936 – 28 December 2008) was an Italian judge and politician. In addition to serving as senator and cabinet minister, he is also known for being a close ally of the former Italian Prime Minister Giulio Andreotti. Carlo Moro was a magistrate and brother of Aldo Moro. Martino Zicchitella was killed on December 14 1976 in Rome by the police. On the December 14, 1976 officer Prisco Palumbo is driving the car escorting the assistant chief Alfonso Noce, head of the security services for Lazio (the regional nucleus of counterterrorism). The car is attacked by terrorists of the Armed Proletarian Nuclei (NAP) stationed in a van. The terrorists start a gunfight. A shot reached the temple of Palumbo. The agent died whilst still driving the car. In the clash the terrorist Martino Zicchitella also lost his life. The Armed Proletarian Nuclei (NAP) were an armed organization of far-left Italy.
