### Description

Paolo Guzzanti (born 1 August 1940) is an Italian journalist and politician. He was previously a member of the Italian Socialist Party. From 2002 to 2006 he was president of the Mitrokhin Commission, a parliamentary commission which was entrusted with investigating the role of KGB in Italy. Gianluigi Melega ( Milan , 12 January 1935 - Venice , 12 September 2014) was a journalist , writer and politician. He was leader of the Radical Party and was elected deputy in the 1979 and 1983 elections. He started as a journalist at The Day , working later in Panorama and The Republic , of which he was a founder. He directed The European from August 1976 to February 1977. He also wrote librettos for composer Luca Mosca. Franco Caracciolo (29 March 1920 – 28 September 1999) was an Italian conductor. is repertory ranged from baroque to contemporary, including operas by Cherubini, Cimarosa, Haydn, Paisiello, and Scarlatti, and 20th century works by Darius Milhaud, Riccardo Malipiero, Nino Rota, and Gino Marinuzzi.
