Manlio Cancogni was a writer, journalist and teacher. In the late sixties he traveled to the United States to teach Italian literature at Smith College in Northampton. Since then he has divided his life between Massachusetts and Marina di Pietrasanta. Ercole Patti was an Italian author, dramatist, screenwriter and journalist. His novels are mainly set in Rome or in a sensual Sicily, which was, according to literary critic Carlo Bo, a sort of philosophical ideal for Patti
