Description

Monica Vitti (born 3 November 1931) is an Italian actress best known for her starring roles in films directed by Michelangelo Antonioni during the early 1960s. After working with Antonioni, Vitti changed focus and began making comedies, working with director Mario Monicelli on many films. She married the director Roberto Russo in 1995, having lived with him since 1975. Roberto Russo is a film director and director of photography. In 1984 he won the David di Donatello for best new director for the debut Flirt (1983), the story of a pair of middle-aged man's imagination makes it a ménage à trois . The female lead is Monica Vitti , his partner in life. Russo directed his wife in two films, Flirt, and Francesca è mia.
