Description

Elsa Martinelli is an Italian actress and former fashion model. From the mid-1950s through the late 1960s, she divided her time between Europe and the United States, appearing in films such as *The Trial* (1962), *The V.I.P.s* (1963), and *Candy* (1968). Since the late 1960s, she has worked in Europe in mostly foreign language productions.

Fritz Gunter Sachs was a German photographer, author, industrialist, and latterly head of an institute that researched claims of astrology. As a young man he became a sportsman, then gained international fame as a documentary film-maker and documentary photographer, and as a playboy - he married three times, Brigitte Bardot was his second wife.
