Description

Pascale Petit is a poet. She was born in Paris and grew up in France and Wales. She trained as a sculptor at the Royal College of Art and was a visual artist for the first part of her life. Walter Chiari was a hugely successful Italian stage and screen actor , mostly in comedy roles. Help is holiday was a television variety of broadcast in 1969 on the National Program . The program was conducted by Walter Chiari, Isabella Biagini, Enrico Simonetti, Felice Andreasi and Pascale Petit. The authors were Leo Chiosso, Eros Macchi and Maurizio Jurgens; It was directed by Eros Macchi, while the orchestra was directed by Franco Pisano. It was a typical summer varieties, of which 7 were transmitted episodes. The program ran for one season.
