Isabel Allende (1945 -) [not to be confused with her cousin, the writer Isabel Allende] is the daughter of Chilean president Salvador Allende, who was assassinated during the 1973 coup d'état of Pinochet. In 1973 she left Chile and lived in exile in Mexico for sixteen years. After her return to Chile she began a successful political career and is currently the president of the Chilean Senate.
