Pier Torri was an Italian producer. He and Austrian actress Marisa Mell lived together for about three years. He had to leave Italy after a notorious cocaine scandal in 1971. Odile Rodin, born in Lyon in 1937, was a French actress and covergirl before she became the fifth and last wife of Porfirio Rubirosa. She adopted the artistic name of Odile Rodin due to the beauty of her body, alluding to the French sculptor Auguste Rodin. Elsa Martinelli is an Italian actress and former fashion model. Régine Zylberberg, better known as Régine, is a Belgian-born French singer and night-club impresaria. She dubbed herself the "Queen of the Night"
