Description

Giuseppe Saragat was an Italian politician who was the fifth President of the Italian Republic from 1964 to 1971.

Pietro Sandro Nenni was an Italian socialist politician, the national secretary of the Italian Socialist Party (PSI) and lifetime Senator since 1970. He was a recipient of the Stalin Peace Prize in 1951. He was a central figure of the Italian left from the 1920s to the 1960s. On placards: "Il fanatismo arabo ha colpito ancora" ["Arab fanaticism strikes again"] "Barbari arricchiti dal petrolio" ["Barbarians made rich by oil"] "Nenni, Saragat, Grazie!" ["Nenni, Saragat, Thank you!"]
