Description

Tom Ponzi (1921-1997) was an Italian private investigator who worked for high-ranking industrial families. In the early 1970s he was accused of illegally wiretapping members of the Montedison company, as well as important politicians. A long legal process began, but Ponzi escaped to Nice, where he remained for six years. When he returned to Italy he was acquitted.
