Description

Mario Tuti (here erroneously confused with Pierluigi Concutelli, another member of Ordine Nuovo) is an Italian terrorist who in the 1970s belonged to the extreme right-wing organization of Ordine Nuovo ('New Order'). With them he helped organize the terrorist attack on the Italicus train in 1974, three other attacks on railways in 1975, and committed a double homicide in 1975. He managed to escape and hid for a while in Tuscany (the photo here refers to him hiding at Palazzo Massoni in Lucca), and overseas, until he was caught and sentenced to life in prison.
