Description

The eponymous prison in Rebibbia is almost square in shape with access road in Bartolo Longo, via Raffaele Majetti and Via Tiburtina. It was designed by architect Sergio Lenci , delivered in 1972 and includes four different prisons and fully autonomous (three male and one female). In each institution are the offices, services for employees and the different sections for the custody of detainees. Female institute is a specific building for the imprisonment of women in prison with young children, who are permitted to reside with his mother until the child reaches three years of age. In the summer of 1973 there was a major revolt in the women's prison.
