Description

Enrico Berlinguer was an Italian politician; he was national secretary of the Italian Communist Party from 1972 until his death. Claudio Signorile is a political and academic Italian , historic exponent of the Italian Socialist Party A member of the Italian Socialist Party since 1956 , covering the first post of national secretary of the Socialist Youth Federation (until 1965), and then a member of the national leadership of the Party, becoming deputy secretary from 1976 to 1981 . Willy Brandt was a German statesman and politician, leader of the Social Democratic Party of Germany (SPD) from 1964 to 1987 and chancellor of the Federal Republic of Germany from 1969 to 1974.
