On banner: "Lama non ci ama: divide i lavoratori; perchè non prova a vivere lui con lo stipendio di 140,000 lire. Se è democratico ed ha coraggio civile venga a parlare con noi" [Lama does not love us: he divides workers. Why doesn't he try to live on 140,000 lire? If he is truly democratic and has a sense of civic courage he should come and talk to us]

Luciano Lama was a trade unionist, politician and partisan, known for being the secretary of the CGIL (the Confederate of Workers) from 1970 to 1986.
