Description

Liceo Guido Castelnuovo was a high school in Rome, that was at the forefront of student demonstrations from the 1960's-70's. It had a largely left-wing population of students and teachers, and was experimenting with more progressive teaching methods, which were discouraged or repressed by the conservative government. In January 1972 the students and teachers went on strike together and protested alongside unionised workers at a large rally.
