Description

Benedetto Craxi, known as Bettino, was an Italian politician in the Italian Socialist Party, Chairman of the Council of Ministers from 4 August 1983 to 17 April 1987. Benito Mussolini was Italy's dictator and founder of Fascism, from 1922 until his ousting in 1943. P2 stands for Propaganda 2, the Masonic Lodge that in the late 1970s was led by Licio Gelli and was exposed for its political corruption, its criminal activities, and the financial scandal that almost bankrupted the Vatican Bank - Bettino Craxi was known to be involved with this Lodge.
