Amintore Fanfani was an Italian politician, economist and historian. His political action was important because he is considered, along with Aldo Moro, Pietro Nenni, Giuseppe Saragat and Ugo La Malfa, one of the architects of the policy shift of the center-left, with which the Christian Democrats wanted to secure the cooperation of the government of the Italian Socialist Party. Ciriaco Luigi De Mita is an Italian politician. He served as the 47th Prime Minister of Italy from 1988 to 1989. As a young man De Mita joined Christian Democracy and entered politics. He rose through the ranks of the party, becoming a member of its council in 1956, a member of Parliament in 1963 and a member of the Italian cabinet in 1973.
