Description

Ciriaco Luigi De Mita is an Italian politician. He served as the 47th Prime Minister of Italy. He was a member of the Italian cabinet in 1973. The Christian Democrats did well in the elections of 1987. De Mita waited a year to become Prime Minister, and then served as Prime Minister for a year, maintaining the party chairmanship. At the beginning of that service, on 16 April 1988, in Forlì, Red Brigades killed Senator Roberto Ruffilli, an advisor of De Mita. Alberto Servidio was a Christian Democrat, and from 1972–1973 was President of Campania.
