Ciccio Franco , born Francesco Franco was a politician , trade unionist and activist. He was an important member of the Italian Social Movement. The term movements of Reggio or revolt of Reggio identifies a riot took place in the popular Reggio Calabria from July 1970 to February 1971 , following the protest due to the decision to place the capital of the region in Catanzaro with the establishment of institutions regional. The Italian Social Movement (MSI), and later the Italian Social Movement – National Right was a neo-fascist and post-fascist political party in Italy.
