Giulio Andreotti was the 41st Prime Minister of Italy and leader of the Christian Democracy party. At the height of his prestige as a statesman, Andreotti was subjected to damaging criminal prosecutions. he most sensational allegation came from prosecutors in Perugia, who charged him with ordering the murder of a journalist. Andreotti remarked "Apart from the Punic Wars, for which I was too young, I have been blamed for everything that's happened in Italy". Benigno Zaccagnini was an Italian politician and physician. In 1975 he was elected National Secretary of Democrazia Cristiana
