Description

An official visit of Italian Members of Parliament, led by Andreotti, in Washington, 3-4 November 1975. At the time, Aldo Moro was Italy's Prime Minister, and Giovanni Leone its President of the Republic. The US President was Gerald Ford. Andreotti's mission was to meet the Secretary of State, Henry Kissinger, to negotiate the USA (and CIA) intervention against the 'Compromesso Storico' (which took place the following year), which would represent a rapprochement with the Communist Party (and in theory with Russia).
