Guido Carli was an Italian banker, economist and politician. His father was the prominent fascist sociologist Filippo Carli. Giovanni "Gianni" Agnelli, also known as L'Avvocato, was an influential Italian industrialist and principal shareholder of Fiat. As the head of Fiat, he controlled 4.4% of Italy's GDP, 3.1% of its industrial workforce, and 16.5% of its industrial investment in research. He was the richest man in modern Italian history. Antonio Giolitti was an Italian politician and cabinet member. He is the grandson of Giovanni Giolitti
