Walter Veltroni is an Italian writer, journalist and politician, who served as the first leader of the Democratic Party within the centre-left opposition, until his resignation on 17 February 2009. He was elected Rome city councillor in 1976 as member of the Italian Communist Party, serving until 1981. Francesco Cossiga was an Italian politician of the Christian Democracy party. He was the 42nd Prime Minister of Italy from 1979 to 1980 and the eighth President of Italy from 1985 to 1992.
