Description

Enrico Berlinguer was an Italian politician; he was national secretary of the Italian Communist Party (PCI) from 1972 until his death. Berlinguer has been described in many ways, but he was generally recognised for political coherence and courage, together with a rare personal and political intelligence. A serious and morally rigorous man, he was sincerely respected even by his opponents. Benigno Zaccagnini was an Italian politician and physician. Zaccagnini was among the founders of the Democrazia Cristiana (Italian Christian Democracy party). He was confirmed at the Chambers of Deputies until 1979, when he was elected to the Italian Senate.
