### Description

Benigno Zaccagnini was an Italian politician and physician. Zaccagnini was among the founders of the Democrazia Cristiana (Italian Christian Democracy party). He was confirmed at the Chambers of Deputies until 1979, when he was elected to the Italian Senate. Ugo La Malfa was an Italian politician, and an important leader in the Italian Republican Party. For many, La Malfa was "the needle" that sewed the Italian republic together and kept it from coming undone, especially because of his role as a peacemaker between contrasting parties.
