Franco Evangelisti was an Italian politician, a member of Democrazia Cristiana (DC) and a long-standing follower of Giulio Andreotti. Amintore Fanfani was an Italian politician and former Prime Minister of Italy. He was one of the best-known Italian politicians after the Second World War, and a historical figure of the left-wing section of the Christian Democracy Party. Giulio Caiati was a teacher and politician with the Christian Democrats. The aim of his political commitment was the economic revival, civil and social life of the South. In particular, the industrial development of Brindisi is the result of his work. Lorenzo Natali Pierucci Bondicchi was an Italian politician. He was an exponent of Amintore Fanfani of the Christian Democrats, and was repeatedly Minister and European Commissioner.
