Description

Rinaldo Ossola (1913 - 1990) was an economist and politician. He was General Director of the Bank of Italy from 1975 to 1976 and Minister of Foreign Trade from 1976 to 1979 in the governments Andreotti III and Andreotti IV. Guido Carli was an Italian banker, economist and politician. His father was the prominent fascist sociologist Filippo Carli. John Bowden Connally, Jr., was an American politician. As a Democrat he served as the 39th Governor of Texas, as Secretary of the Navy under President John F. Kennedy, and as Secretary of the Treasury under President Richard M. Nixon. As Treasury Secretary, Connally is best remembered for removing the U.S. dollar from the gold standard in 1971, an event known as the Nixon shock.
