Amintore Fanfani was an Italian politician, economist and historian. His political action was important because he is considered, along with Aldo Moro, Pietro Nenni, Giuseppe Saragat and Ugo La Malfa, one of the architects of the policy shift of the center-left, with which the Christian Democrats wanted to secure the co-operation of the government Italian Socialist Party. Carlo Donat-Cattin was an Italian politician and trade unionist. A member of Christian Democracy, he was several times minister of the Italian Republic.
