Emilio Colombo was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. Colombo entered politics as a member of the Christian Democracy in 1948. He was firstly elected to the parliament in 1948. Paolo Bonomi was a politician for the Christian Democrats. He founded Coldiretti (National Confederation of Farmers), which is the largest association of representation and assistance for the Italian agriculture industry.
