Luigi Granelli was a political Italian , a member of the Christian Democratic Party , several times minister and undersecretary at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the governments Rumor IV , V Rumor , Moro IV and V Moro . Emilio Colombo was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. He was a member of the Christian Democracy Franco Malfatti di Monte Tretto was an Italian politician and President of the European Commission. Malfatti was born in Rome. He was an important member of the governing council of Democrazia Cristiana (the Christian Democratic party) in which he became chief of political bureau, and covered several institutional charges. Giovanni Galloni is a jurist, politician and Italian academic. He was one of the founders of the left wing section of the Christian Democrats and was also vice president of the party and twice deputy secretary, in 1965 and in 1977.
