Description

Emilio Colombo was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. He was a member of the Christian Democracy. Bruno Morassutti was an Italian architect, born in 1920 in Padova, died in 2008. He was active in the 50s and 60s, designing modern buildings inspired by American architects like Frank Lloyd Wright and Mies van der Rohe, and opening a partnership with Angelo Mangiarotti in 1955 which ran until 1960.
