Description

Carlo Donat-Cattin was an Italian politician and trade unionist. A member of Christian Democracy, he was several times minister of the Italian Republic. Ciriaco De Mita is an Italian politician. He served as the 47th Prime Minister of Italy from 1988 to 1989. As a young man De Mita joined Christian Democracy and entered politics. He rose through the ranks of the party, becoming a member of its council in 1956, a member of Parliament in 1963 and a member of the Italian cabinet in 1973. Flaminio Piccoli was an Italian politician, a member of Christian Democracy until its dissolution in 1994, then a member of the Italian People's Party and in 1995, a member of the United Christian Democrats. In 1997, he started the Rinascita della Democrazia Cristiana ("Rebirth of Christian Democracy" party).
