Description

Gabriele Cagliari was chief of the Italian state energy combine, Ente Nazionale Idrocarburi. The huge company, widely known as ENI, helped to create Enimont - a conglomerate of chemicals companies - and eventually took control of it in a series of stock purchases that may have generated hundreds of millions of dollars in kickbacks and bribes. ENI S.p.A. is an Italian multinational oil and gas company headquartered in Rome. It has operations in 79 countries, and is currently world's 11th largest industrial company.
