Don Antonio Mazzi is a priest and writer Italian, engaged in activities for recovering addicts . Between 1962 and 1965 in Rome and Milan attended some specialised courses in psychology and educational psychology , then he moved to Bologna where he studied psychoanalysis of the institutions at the faculty of pedagogy special with Andrea Canevaro . Since 1970 he continued his studies abroad (United States , Germany , Netherlands , France , Switzerland) making internships in rehabilitation centers for drug addicts . In 1980 he founded the Exodus Community for recovering drug addicts. Publishes the ' Agenda Tremendous , a diary school, now called Tremendous desire to live .
