Description

Pietro Palazzini (May 19, 1912 – October 11, 2000) was an Italian Cardinal who helped to save the lives of Jewish people in World War II. Born in Piobbico, near Pesaro, he was ordained a priest in 1934, consecrated by the pope in 1962 and was elevated to the cardinalate in 1973.
