Description

Luigi Bettazzi is an Italian Prelate of Roman Catholic Church. Bettazzi was born in Treviso and was ordained a priest on 4 August 1946. Bettazzi was appointed Auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Bologna, as well as titular bishop of Thagaste, on 10 August 1963 and ordained on 4 October 1963. Bettazzi was appointed bishop of the Diocese of Ivrea on 26 November 1966 where he would remain until his retirement on 20 February 1999. Bartolomeo Sorge (born 1929) is a Jesuit priest, theologian and Italian political scientist, experienced social doctrine of the Church (a set of principles, theories, teachings and directives issued by the Catholic Church with regard to the social and economic problems of the contemporary world), and an exponent of the so-called 'democratic Catholicism'. He has always fought against the 'fundamentalism' of some Catholic movements, which the "Evangelization and Human Promotion" conference, held in 1976 , had called 'the worm of the Gospel'.
