Description

Leopoldo Pirelli was an Italian businessman. He was the president of Pirelli from 1965 to 1996, and he was elected vice-president of Confindustria in 1974. Alejandro de Tomaso was a racing driver and industrialist from Argentina. Despite his Formula One career, de Tomaso was much more significant in the motoring world as a maker of cars. He founded the Italian sports car company De Tomaso Automobili in 1959, and later built up a substantial business empire.
