Alberto Arbasino is an Italian writer and essayist. He worked as journalist for magazines such as *Il Mondo* and the newspaper *La Repubblica*. From 1983 to 1987, he was deputy to the Italian Parliament for the Italian Republican Party. Umberto Eco is an Italian semiotician, essayist, philosopher, literary critic, and novelist. He is best known for his groundbreaking 1980 historical mystery novel *Il nome della rosa* (The Name of the Rose), an intellectual mystery combining semiotics in fiction, biblical analysis, medieval studies and literary theory.
