Eugenio Scalfari with his lawyer at a tribunal investigating his newspaper L'Espresso, which broke the story of the coup planned by the Italian secret service SIFAR and President of the Italian Republic, Antonio Segni Piano Solo was an envisaged plot for an Italian coup in 1964 requested by then President of the Italian Republic, Antonio Segni. It was prepared by the commander of the Carabinieri Giovanni de Lorenzo in the beginning of 1964 in close collaboration with the Italian secret service SIFAR. The coup plans were investigated in 1967, when the journalist Eugenio Scalfari and Lino Jannuzzi uncovered the attempt in the Italian news magazine L'Espresso in May 1967.
