Description

The Italian Social Movement (MSI), and later the Italian Social Movement – National Right, was a neo-fascist and post-fascist political party in Italy. During the late 1970s and early 1980s, the second wave of right-wing terrorism in Italy led some MSI members to become radicalised, and some left the party to form new groups. Balduina, population 42,000, is an urban area that belongs to the Municipio XIX of the commune of Rome
